

Dear Students & Parents,

I wanted to get this letter out to you to let you know about an awesome event that is coming up Saturday, August 10th called COLLIDE Boot Camp. This will be a fun filled day for our incoming 6th grade students to join our 7th grade students for a day of fun games, fellowship, and helping them know and understand the vision and culture of the student ministry by teaching them the core values and foundational beliefs of the student ministry.

In short, our five core values come from our student ministry verse 1 Timothy 4:12, "Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity." Promotion Sunday beginning during our Sunday morning Bible study time at 9:30am. Student will meet on the 3rd Floor of the church, and we will be happy to help your family find a class to participate in. We would love to have you join us for morning worship beginning at 10:50am in the auditorium.
